Bio: Professor Joachim Funke is full professor for cognitive and experimental psychology (retired) at the Department of Psychology at the University of Heidelberg, Germany. He holds a PhD in cognitive psychology from the University of Trier (1984) and a honorary doctor from Szeged University (2015). Funke has been and is project director of a number of research projects funded by national and international institutions. He published numerous articles for national and international scientific journals, contributed to many book editions, and wrote and edited books himself. From 2010 until 2014, Joachim was chair of the PISA Problem Solving Expert Group. Funke's primarily interests are issues within problem solving and thinking research, especially measurement aspects. He is one of the promoters of the European approach of Complex Problem Solving which uses computer-simulated microworlds for assessment of problem solving competencies.
